In 2007, John was instrumental in identifying the hospital as an acquisition candidate for Merit Health Systems, a private company based in Louisville, KY, where he was a partner and Senior Vice President. He subsequently relocated to New Jersey to assume the role of CEO and personally oversee the hospital's transformation. Under his leadership, the hospital has undergone a successful and dramatic revitalization.

In 2012, recognizing that network affiliations were becoming increasingly essential to maintaining clinical excellence and financial viability, John was instrumental in negotiating the sale of Mountainside to a not-for-profit/for-profit joint venture network between Hackensack University Medical Center and LHP Hospital Group, now Hackensack Meridian Health and Ardent Health Services.

Prior to joining Merit, John was a Group Vice President for Community Health Systems with direct responsibility for 13 hospitals in five states. He also held senior management positions with Humana and HCA. He is a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives.

John and his wife Cheryl live in Verona, and have four sons and two granddaughters.


"Excellence"- a word that drives John's temperament. He demands it within himself and expects it in others. He inspires people to perform their work at their highest quality and competency.

According to the United Way of Northern New Jersey ALICE Report, 37% of New Jersey households could not afford housing, child care, food, health care and transportation in 2014. In 2018, Montclair Public Library, in collaboration with Toni's Kitchen, served brown-bag lunches to almost 3,000 children over 10 weeks, a 20% increase from 2017. 1 in 8 children struggles with hunger in New Jersey. A lack of healthy food can seriously impact a child's physical & mental health, academic achievement and economic prosperity.

The Salvation Army in Montclair served more than 23,000 meals at breakfast and lunchtime during the 2017-18 fiscal year.


Human Needs Food Pantry distributes an average of 2,537 bags of food to 2,470 families each month.

According to the 2018 Point in Time Count, of the 1,654 homeless households counted in Essex County in 2018, 299 (18%) were families with at least one child under the age of 18. Close to 1 in 3 college students choose between paying for food or educational expenses.

According to Feeding America, 66% of households have to choose between food or medical care.



Only 1 in 6 children and teens who receive free or reduced-price meals at school also receive free meals during the summer.

42.5% of households in New Jersey receiving SNAP benefits have children.





For the 2017-2018 school year, 782 students, 13.5% of the Montclair district, qualified for free or reduced lunch.

A Lot to Grow community gardens have produced more than 27,000 pounds of fresh vegetables and herbs for local food pantries and soup kitchens since 2010.

Partners for Health Foundation addresses local hunger and homelessness through grants that include:

- Matching dollars at local Farmers' Markets and traveling veggie mobiles for seniors, SNAP and WIC recipients, implemented in partnership with City Green.
- Free tax preparation services provided by New Jersey Citizen Action which has resulted in refunds of more than \$1.9 million since 2016, including \$561,627 in Earned Income Tax Credits.
- Financial literacy workshops on budgeting, credit repair, savings, foreclosure prevention and home ownership.
- Support to implement "Breakfast After the Bell" programs for students who qualify for a free breakfast, but aren't able to get to school early to receive the meal.
- Fresh produce grants to soup kitchens and food pantries, because inadequate intake of costly fruits and vegetables is prevalent among low-income individuals, who also experience higher rates of chronic health issues such as heart disease, high blood pressure and obesity.
